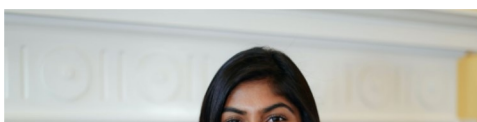
Welcome to The Boehly Center Monthly Happenings newsletter!
